

The Holy Spirit is a Person

- Recognized as a Person
 - Jn. 14:17 the personal pronoun “He” or “Him” is used four (4) times
 - Relating to the Spirit of God as a Person puts Him in a different light
- Attributes of His personality
 - Intellect: Rom. 8:27, 1 Cor. 2:10-11
 - Emotion: Eph. 4:30
 - Volition: 1 Cor. 12:7,11; Acts 13:2

The Holy Spirit is God

- Attributes
 - Omniscient: Isa. 40:13-14
 - Omnipresent: Ps. 139:7
 - Eternal: Heb. 9:14
 - Truth: 1 Jn. 5:7; Jn. 16:13
- Statements of Deity
 - 2 Cor. 3:17
 - Acts 5:3-4
 - Lying to the Holy Spirit is lying to God

The Work of the Holy Spirit

- The Holy Spirit is active in the earth (Ps. 104:30)
- The Holy Spirit is active in prophecy and writing the scriptures (1 Pet. 2:20-21)
- The Holy Spirit bears witness of Christ
 - Attests that Jesus is the Christ (Jn. 15:26)
 - Will disclose or reveal Christ (Jn. 16:14)
 - Will not speak of Himself (Jn. 16:13)

The Ministry of the Holy Spirit In Salvation

- His work in God's plan of salvation
 - Reproving, convicting of sin (Jn. 16:7-8)
 - Birthing into the Kingdom of God (Jn. 3:5-8)
 - Washing and renewing the believer (Ti. 3:5-6)
 - Forming the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:13)
 - Guarantee of salvation (Eph. 1:13-14)
 - Seal indicates ownership and security

The Ministry of the Holy Spirit In the Believer's Life

- The Holy Spirit indwells the believer; a special relationship (Rom. 8:9)
- The Holy Spirit is our Teacher (1 Cor. 2:12-13)
- Exhortation to believers regarding the Holy Spirit
 - Do not grieve Him (Eph. 4:30)
 - Do not quench Him (1 Thess. 5:19)
 - Be filled with Him (Eph. 5:18)
- Best way to keep from sinning
 - Gal. 5:16
