

The Person of Jesus Christ

- Jesus is the central person of all human history
 - Before He came, life pointed to Him
 - After He arose, life points back to Him
- Pilate shared a statement that every person has to ask
 - Mt. 27:22
 - “What shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?”
- To answer, we have to know Who He is

The Person of Jesus Christ

- The God Who became man:
 - Phil. 2:6
 - Form of God
 - Phil. 2:7
 - Was “Ok” with being a servant
- Fully human
 - Slept (Mk. 4:38)
 - Hungry (Lk. 4:2)
 - Sad (Jn. 11:35)
 - Heb. 4:15-16

The Person of Jesus Christ

- Fully God
 - Sovereign (Mk. 28:18)
 - Eternal (1 Jn. 1:1-2)
 - Unchanging (immutable; Heb. 13:8)
 - All-knowing (omniscient; Col. 2:2b-3)
 - Perfect / sinless (2 Cor. 5:21)
 - Holy (Acts 3:14-15)
 - Truth (Jn. 14:6)

The Person of Jesus Christ

- Demonstrated omnipotence
 - Power over wind and waves (Mt. 8:23-27)
 - Power over diseases (Lk. 4:40)
 - Power over unclean spirits (Lk. 4:33-36)
 - Power of death (Jn. 11:43-44)
 - Power to forgive sins (Mk. 2:3-12)
 - Mk. 2:7 (only God can forgive sins)

The Person of Jesus Christ

- Christ as Savior
 - Jn. 1:29: Lamb of God (sacrifice)
 - Jn. 6:35: Bread of life (fills the void)
 - Jn. 14:6: Way, Truth, Life (only way to the Father)
- Christ as the King that comes to rule
 - Dan. 7:14
 - Christ has been given:
 - Dominion
 - Glory
 - Kingdom

The Person of Jesus Christ

- Christ as the King that comes to rule
 - Mt. 25:31
 - He will come with the entourage of holy angels and sit on the throne
 - Acts 1:11
 - He is coming back! The same Jesus!
 - 2 Thess. 1:7b-10
 - When He returns, He will take vengeance on those that do not know God and obey not the gospel of Jesus Christ
 - Came first as Savior, next time as the ruling King!
