- God's sovereign plan of salvation
 - The progression of how God brings someone to salvation
 - Rom. 8:29-30
- Eph. 1:4-6
 - God's plan since before the foundation of the world

God's Sovereignty in Salvation

- God implements His plan of salvation
 - Man's condition before salvation (Eph. 2:1)
 - What the Holy Ghost does concerning sin (Jn. 16:8)
 - What is needed before someone can know the truth (2 Tim. 2:25)
 - Right to become children of God is granted by Jesus (Jn. 1:12-13)
 - Notice how this right is granted
 - Not of birth
 - Not our own efforts
 - Not our own volition

Conversion

- Conviction of Sin
 - Rom. 3:20
- Repentance from Sin (2 Cor. 7:9-10)
 - What godly sorrow over sin produces, leads to (vs. 10)
- Turning to Christ
 - The promise to those calling on Christ (Rom. 10:13)
 - What we have to confess, believe (Rom. 10:9)
- Becoming slaves to righteousness
 - What we are free from (Rom. 8:2)
 - The benefit (Rom. 6:22)

Evidence of Salvation

- Evidences of salvation (1 Thess. 1:3-4)
 - Faith that works
 - Love that labors
 - Hope that endures
- Faith that works
 - Genuine faith seen
 - Jms. 2:18
 - 1 Pet. 1:6-7
 - Titus 3:8

Evidence of Salvation

- Love that labors
 - What God takes note of (Heb. 6:10)
 - Source of love in the life of the believer (Rom. 5:5)
 - What is true about a person born of God (1 Jn. 4:7-8)
 - How a believer shows love (1 Jn. 3:18-19)
- Hope that endures
 - Those who will be saved (Mt. 10:22)
 - Our motivation to endure (1 Tim. 4:10)
 - Hope we have
 - Gal. 5:5; 1 Thess. 5:8; Titus 3:7
