 - Not understanding
 - Not seeking God
 - Gone out of the way
 - Unprofitable
 - Not doing good
 - Man is a slave to sin (Jn. 8:34)
 - The result of sin is death (Jms. 1:15)
 - Were the children of disobedience (Eph. 2:1-3)

- Man's Need for Christ's work
 - God will not tolerate sin
 - God asserts His holiness and demands conformity to it
 - We are faced with:
 - Sin (Rom. 3:23)
 - Having God as an enemy (Jms. 4:4b)
 - Subjection to the power of Satan (1 Jn. 5:19)
 - Being helpless to save himself (Rom. 5:6)
 - Death (Rom. 6:23)
 - Condemnation and eternal separation from God (2 Thess. 1:9)

- The Cost of Christ's Work
 - From Phil. 2:7-8, Jesus
 - Made Himself of no reputation
 - Took on the form of a Servant
 - Was made in the likeness of men
 - Jesus humbled Himself through being obedient unto death
 - In Isa. 55:3, Jesus
 - Was rejected
 - Despised
 - Acquainted with grief

- The Cost of Christ's Work
 - The forgiveness of sins required the shedding of blood (Heb. 9:22)
 - This cost Jesus His life (1 Pet. 1:18-19)
 - Jesus becoming sin meant He was forsaken by the Father (Mt. 27:46)
 - God laid the iniquity of us ALL on Jesus (Isa. 53:6)
- The Provisions of Christ's Work
 - Bring us to God (1 Pet. 3:18)
 - Reconciled us to God (Rom. 5:10)

- The Provisions of Christ's Work
 - Bring us to God (1 Pet. 3:18)

 - Made us the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:21)
 - Delivered us from this present evil (Gal. 1:4)
